HOTEL REOPENING HYGIENE MEASURES (COVID-19)

All suite linen (sheets, pillow covers, blankets etc) will be replaced after each use/departure.

All mattresses have been cleaned and sanitized prior to the hotel opening.

All carpets have been cleaned and disinfected prior to the hotel opening.

We ensure there is adequate fresh air ventilation by keeping windows and doors open as much as possible.
